## Bulletin 28 (Protecting vulnerable people)

### Call handling

Multiple missing person's logs were opened and closed without a woman or her children being seen. Opportunities to progress the investigation were missed. She was later murdered by her estranged husband.



### Information management

A woman was seriously injured by her ex-partner after information that he was potentially violent was not shared with her.



### Firearms

A man held a legal firearm. Patterns of his coercive behaviour were missed by officers, who did not share relevant information with the Firearms Licensing Department. The man went on to shoot his wife, who died.



### Crime and investigation

There were delays in investigating an allegation of sexual assault. A young woman was subsequently raped by the person the allegation had been made against.



### Crime and investigation

A delay in carrying out a DBS check meant that a man who had purchased child exploitation material was able to continue in his job, which involved contact with children.
